The Springhaven Club

History

The Springhaven Country Club was formed in October 1896 by our “founding” mother, Eleanor Reed. Eleanor toured Europe in the summer of 1896, saw golf being played in France, tried it herself, fell under its spell and the rest is history.

Eleanor quickly recruited enthusiastic followers, including Dr. Casper T. Miller and Henry and Ida Dixon. The Springhaven Country Club was launched by initially leasing a parcel of land known as "Springhaven Farm" from a dairy farmer, at Providence Road and Jackson Street in Media. The club's first president was George T. Butler, Eleanor's husband, and Eleanor Reed Butler served as the first secretary.

An old springhouse on the property served early-on as the locker room. The course originally consisted of nine-holes with a total length of 2,940 yards. The first hole measured 600 yards, and the second 520 yards. Each was a par 5 1/2. In an age when a 160-yard drive was considered little short of Herculean, these opening holes must have been exhausting and seemed endless. While the other seven holes were what one would expect, (240 yards, 200, 434, 384, 176, 133, and 253) the beginning of the round must have been demoralizing.

Membership increased rapidly and the facilities were soon outgrown. In late 1903, the present property in Wallingford was purchased. Ida Dixon was responsible for the design of the course making her the first female golf course architect in America. The club was officially dedicated on July 9, 1904. The facilities included a splendid clubhouse with broad brick terraces; a two-story high assembly hall with a beamed ceiling, an open fireplace, and a musician's balcony; a dining room with an open fireplace and fitted china closets; a card room; a taproom with rustic inglenook; a billiards room; locker and shower rooms; and guest rooms and suites for visiting golfers.

The Springhaven Country Club even had its own golf professional, Horace Rawlins, an historic figure in American golf. Horace, at the age of 21, won the inaugural U.S. Open Championship in 1895, at the Newport Golf Club, in Rhode Island. Horace Rawlins served Springhaven well, selling equipment and giving lessons until 1909.

All scorecards for the 2011 Golf Season must be turned in to the Pro Shop with player's first and last name and local numbers. Players will be responsible for posting their own scores in 2011.

For all play at this course, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. However, if, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect their play (e.g., gradient, wind-speed, temperature, etc.) the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used.

TOURNAMENT POLICIES

Tournament policies will be published annually by the Men's Golf Committee, and may be supplemented via individual tournament rule sheets. If they are in conflict with statements appearing in other Club publications, these tournament policies will take precedence.

Eligibility:

Only Certificate and Intermediate members with full golfing privileges may participate in Club sponsored golf events. Non-resident members may play if they have contributed to the Prize Fund and have sufficient rounds left to complete the tournament. Junior golfers fifteen years of age and older and approved by the Committee are permitted to play in any entry fee tournament and in the Club Championship (both Match Play and Stroke Play), the Horace Rawlins and the Springhaven Cup Invitational.

Prize Fund:

All Certificate and Intermediate members are billed annually in their dues for the Prize Fund. The Prize Fund covers the following tournaments:

- Opening Day
- Player's Cup
- Club Championship (Match Play)
- Memorial Day Better Ball
- Derby
- President's Cup
- Anniversary Tournament
- Club Championship (Stroke Play)
- Over-Under
- Founder's Cup
- Senior Club Championship
- Ryder Cup Matches
- Member/Member Tournament

Rules:

All competitive events will be conducted in accordance with the Rules of Golf as set forth by the United States Golf Association. All rounds in these events will start on the first tee, unless otherwise directed by the Committee. All holes will be played in succession. All putts in stroke play competition and other applicable events must be holed out. Copies of the Rules of Golf booklets are available from the USGA for a minimal charge. Players are responsible for knowing the Rules of Golf and the conditions under which a competition is to be played (Rule 6-1 / Rule 33-1).

Entries:

Tournament sign-up sheets will be posted inside the Professional Shop at least two (2) weeks prior to each event, and will detail the conditions under which the tournament will be played. Entries may be made by telephone through the Professional Staff. For weekend events, the sign-up deadline will be 12:00 noon on Thursday prior to the event. Players entering after the deadline are not guaranteed a spot in the tournament field. Pairings and starting times will be posted in the Professional Shop by 12:00 noon on the Friday prior to the event.

Teams:

In those tournaments in which teams are made by members themselves (not by the Committee), players who are unable to link up with another member should indicate this on the sign-up sheet. The Committee will randomly draw teams from this list to allow the unattached members to compete.

Tee Times (Pairings):

Pairings and tee times will be assigned and will be the responsibility of the golf professional or his designee. With some tournaments, players may request starting times, and efforts will be made within the spirit of the event to accommodate such requests.

Note: In certain two-day tournaments, second day tee times are based on first day scores. Therefore, tee time requests cannot be made.

Handicaps:

Men's golf members must maintain their handicaps per the posted USGA regulations on the computerized system provided. The current computer USGA handicaps will be used for all tournament rounds. The Handicap Committee may adjust any player's handicap in accordance with Section 8 of the USGA Handicap System manual. In order for a player to participate in a tournament, the Committee may require a minimum number of recent local scores posted or, in lieu of this, may adjust the player's handicap per the USGA Handicap System manual. The Hubber System will be used to adjust players' handicaps for each tournament. It works off of the player's current handicap index and the player's two (2) tournament indexes from the past 12 months. It essentially goes through all the players of the tournament of the day and assigns a tournament handicap if needed.

Member-Guest (One-Day Stag Day) Handicaps:

A member is responsible for the handicap of his guest. Preferably, all guests will have a current USGA handicap. Any player not having a current USGA handicap will play in a separate tournament.

Member-Guest (Annual Member-Guest) Handicaps:

All guests:

- Must have a USGA approved handicap
- Cannot establish a handicap at The Springhaven Club unless they are a House Member
- Must have at least 10 scores between the dates of June 18, 2010, and June 16, 2011.

Flighting:

Certain tournaments will be flighted by handicap or by criteria determined by the Committee. In these events, team/individual handicaps or scores will be sorted, and then grouped to constitute a particular flight. Teams or individuals will play within their flight and upon completion the flight winners may or may not play off against each other to determine the overall event championship. Handicap strokes may or may not apply within flights.

Course Marking/Set-up:

The marking of the course is the responsibility of the golf professional or his designee. Regarding course set-up (tee locations, hole locations, etc.), the golf professional will work in conjunction with the grounds superintendent or his designee.

Ties/Playoffs:

All ties for first place in stroke play events, the final position in qualifying rounds, and match play will be decided by a sudden death playoff. The playoff will commence on the first hole, and will be played in order thereafter by the scorecard for as long as necessary. All other ties will be decided by a match of cards with the best score on the last nine holes, the last six holes, the last three holes, the last hole, and finally in succession beginning on the lowest handicap hole until the tie is broken. Identical rounds will be played off under sudden death conditions. In net events, handicap strokes will apply as indicated on the scorecard. At the discretion of the Committee, the method of breaking ties may be modified in accordance with the Rules of Golf.

Gross/Net Prizes:

In tournaments offering both gross and net prizes, individuals or teams may win in either classification, but not both.

In the Players Cup and the Founders Cup, if a player wins both the Gross Championship and the Net Championship outright, the player will forfeit his position on the Net side and be declared the Gross Champion. If a player wins one Championship outright and ties for the other Championship, the player will forfeit his position that he is tied for and be declared the Champion of the Championship that he won outright. If a player ties for both Championships, the player must choose which Championship he wishes to compete for and forfeit his position in the other Championship.

Results:

Tournament results will be posted outside the Professional Shop and in the Professional Shop as soon as practical after the tournament is completed. Credits will be distributed at this time to the member's Professional Shop account. Results posted will include pro shop credits earned.

Posting Scores:

It is the responsibility of the player to turn all his scorecards in and post their own scores in accordance with USGA Handicap guidelines. The posting of tournament scores will be the responsibility of the golf professional. The following tournaments will be flagged with "T's" for tournament scores:

- Player's Cup
- Founder's Cup
- President's Cup Qualifying
- Club Championship Match Play Qualifying
- Club Championship Stroke Play
- Derby Qualifying
- Horace Rawlins
- Ryder Cup Qualifying
- Any further Tournaments that the Handicap Committee deems necessary to add. Competitors will be notified in advance of these Tournaments.

Scores in match play events shall be posted per guidelines set forth by the USGA. The Handicap Chairman will review all postings.

Slow Play:

All players shall play without undue delay and in accordance with any pace of play guidelines, which may be laid down by the Committee. Between the completion of a hole and playing from the next teeing ground, the player shall not unduly delay play. (See Rule 6-7.)

2011 PACE OF PLAY GUIDELINES

The posted time for an 18-hole round of golf for a foursome is 4 hours.

1. WEEKEND PACE OF PLAY

A Pace of Play notice will be posted at the starters table every Saturday and Sunday morning. No group should take more than the posted Pace of Play time to complete a round of 18 holes. Any group playing before 9 am on Saturday or Sunday, and taking longer than the posted Pace of Play time to complete their round, will be notified of their pace of play infraction. The first

notification of the pace of play infraction will be considered a warning. **Any member receiving a second infraction of the pace of play rule will not be permitted to tee off before 9 am on Saturday or Sunday for a period of two weeks after notification of the second infraction. Any additional infraction will receive the same tee off time restriction.**

2. DEFINITION OF OUT OF POSITION

First Group off the 1st or 10th Tee – The group exceeds the time allotted to play at any time during the round.

All other groups – The group, at any time during the round (a) exceeds the allotted time to play AND (b) reaches the teeing ground on a par 3 or par 4 hole when the group ahead has cleared the green OR on a par 5 hole when the group ahead has reached the green.

3. NOTIFICATION OF PLAYERS OUT OF POSITION

If a group is out of position, the players will be notified verbally by a member of the Committee or staff.

Once notified, the players in the group will be subject to timing of their strokes as described in the section below.

4. TIMING OF PLAYERS OUT OF POSITION

When players in a group are being timed, the Committee member doing the timing will notify them verbally.

When timing of strokes begins:

On All Parts of the Course except the Putting Green – Timing of a stroke begins when it is the player's turn to play and he can play without interference or distraction. (Time spent determining yardage and conditions counts in the time taken to play a stroke.)

On the Putting Green – Timing of a stroke from the putting green begins when it is the player's turn to play, he can play without interference or distraction, and has had a reasonable amount of time to (1) mark, lift and clean his ball, (2) repair his ball mark, (3) repair other ball marks on his line of putt, and (4) remove loose impediments from his line of putt. (Time spent reading the green counts in the time taken to play a stroke from the putting green.)

5. CRITERIA FOR DETERMINING AND PENALTIES FOR UNDUE DELAY IN TOURNAMENT COMPETITION

If a group is out of position, a player will be deemed to have a bad timing and be subject to penalty under Rule 6-7 (Undue Delay) if he takes 45 seconds or more to play a stroke (except in extraordinary circumstances).

Penalty for Breach of Rule 6-7 (Undue Delay)

Stroke Play

- One Bad Timing - Warning
- Two Bad Timings – Second Warning
- Third Bad Timing - 1 Stroke
- A Subsequent Bad Timing – 2 Strokes

Match Play

- One Bad Timing - Warning
- Two Bad Timings – Second Warning
- A Third Bad Timing – Loss of Hole

NOTES:

A player who incurs one bad timing will be notified of such by the Committee as soon as practicable and warned that any subsequent bad timing during that round will subject him to penalty under Rule 6-7 (Undue Delay).

The Committee will notify a player incurring a penalty under this rule as soon as practicable.

When a group being timed regains their proper position on the course, the Committee will immediately suspend the monitoring or timing.

The position of the group following has no bearing in determining whether or not a player's pace of play is satisfactory under this policy.

The Committee will determine the time allotted for play.

The Board of Governors and the Golf Committee has charged the Professional Staff with enforcing this Pace of Play Policy and will support them in their efforts to this end. If players have issue with the Professional Staff in how they enforce this policy, all comments should be directed to the Golf Committee Chairman.

Tournament and Qualifying Rounds:

All tournament qualifying and competitive rounds must be played with a fellow-competitor or marker, and within the times designated by the Committee.

Match Scheduling and Results:

Matches in major tournaments must be completed by the date noted in the schedule. In any match, if the two opposing sides cannot agree on a time to play their match outside of the time set down by the Committee, the match must be played at the set time. The side not present shall be disqualified. It is the responsibility of the winner of a match to inform the golf professional of the outcome.

Preferred Lies:

The decision to play "preferred lies" in tournaments is the responsibility of the Committee, and will be conducted under the guidelines of Appendix I of the Rules of Golf.

Disputes and Decisions:

The head golf professional is appointed the referee, and will decide all disputes and questions regarding the Rules of Golf.

Multiple Day Withdrawal Policy:

Any player that withdraws from an individual, multiple day qualifier after the first round without good cause will not be able to participate in that tournament the following year. Any player withdrawing from or not playing in an assigned match while participating in a team event without good cause will not be able to participate in that tournament the following year. Good cause will be defined by the Golf Committee on a case by case basis.

Hole-In-One Insurance:

The Springhaven Club is insured on an annual basis for the first six (6) hole-in-ones in the designated tournaments.

HOLE-IN-ONE PRIZE FUND

**New for the 2011 Golf Season is the Hole-In-One (HIO)
Prize Fund for all Golfing Members and their spouses.**

Details of the program are as follows:

- The HIO Prize Fund is at the Member's option.
- The fee for the HIO Prize Fund is \$5 every time a hole-in-one is registered by a participant of the program. The \$5 fee initially will be billed to the member's account when they sign up. For each subsequent HIO, another \$5 will be billed to the Member's account.
- Only a HIO at Springhaven will be paid out.
- Time frame for a hole-in-one to be considered for pay out will be April 1st through October 31st.
- 100% of the payout will be credited to the Member's House account.
- Once a Member has opted in for the prize fund, they are committed for the entire season.
- The HIO must be witnessed by at least one other person.
- A form will need to be filled out by the player who had the HIO and the witness(es) of the hole-in-one verifying all pertinent information.
- Players may not claim a HIO on a mulligan. It must be the original shot.
- Only a HIO hit from a regulation tee to a regulation green will be considered.
- Membership to the HIO Prize Fund is exclusive to one person only. Spouses must be a member of the HIO Prize Fund separately.
- Any funds left at the end of the golf year roll over to the next season.
- Sign-up is at the Pro Shop.
