## **Ready Golf Means Faster Play**

**According to the USGA, a 2-some should finish 18-hole play in 3 hours, 36 minutes. That's 12 minutes per hole!**

- Get to the tee promptly and be ready to hit. If the person with “honors” is not ready, let that golfer hit later.
- Minimize practice swings.
- Clean your club and place in bag while on the tee, unless you're the last to tee off.
- If you're the last to tee off, do not clean and place club in bag. Get in cart and go immediately to next tee. Clean and place club in cart while others tee off.
- Watch the flight and destination of the ball, marking its resting place with a visual reference to a tree, shadow, or other landmark.
- Plan the next shot as soon as the ball comes to rest.
- Walk or ride directly to you ball.
- Observe the yardage markers along the way.
- Take more than one club if the selection is in doubt.
- Share the cart driving so that the player having the next shot is driven to their shot.
- When playing in a 3-some, help the third player to advance their cart whenever possible.
- Line up your putt while others are lining up their putts.
- When you putt and miss within a foot of the hole, ask if you can finish.
- Play the right course for you. Tees are no longer identified by sex.
- If each golfer cuts their hole time by 15 seconds...a 4-some will finish 18 minutes sooner, a 2-some will finish 9 minutes sooner!

# *The Springhaven Club*

## History

The Springhaven Country Club was formed in October 1896 by our “founding” mother, Eleanor Reed. Eleanor toured Europe in the summer of 1896, saw golf being played in France, tried it herself, fell under its spell and the rest is history.

Eleanor quickly recruited enthusiastic followers, including Dr. Casper T. Miller and Henry and Ida Dixon. The Springhaven Country Club was launched by initially leasing a parcel of land known as “Springhaven Farm” from a dairy farmer, at Providence Road and Jackson Street in Media. The club’s first president was George T. Butler, Eleanor’s husband, and Eleanor Reed Butler served as the first secretary.

An old springhouse on the property served early-on as the locker room. The course originally consisted of nine-holes with a total length of 2,940 yards. The first hole measured 600 yards, and the second 520 yards. Each was a par 5 1/2. In an age when a 160-yard drive was considered little short of Herculean, these opening holes must have been exhausting and seemed endless. While the other seven holes were what one would expect, (240 yards, 200, 434, 384, 176, 133, and 253) the beginning of the round must have been demoralizing.

Membership increased rapidly and the facilities were soon outgrown. In late 1903, the present property in Wallingford was purchased. Ida Dixon was responsible for the design of the course making her the first female golf course architect in America. The club was officially dedicated on July 9, 1904. The facilities included a splendid clubhouse with broad brick terraces; a two-story high assembly hall with a beamed ceiling, an open fireplace, and a musician's balcony; a dining room with an open fireplace and fitted china closets; a card room; a taproom with rustic inglenook; a billiards room; locker and shower rooms; and guest rooms and suites for visiting golfers.

The Springhaven Country Club even had its own golf professional, Horace Rawlins, an historic figure in American golf. Horace, at the age of 21, won the inaugural U.S. Open Championship in 1895, at the Newport Golf Club, in Rhode Island. Horace Rawlins served Springhaven well, selling equipment and giving lessons until 1909.

## EXPLANATION OF TROPHY EVENTS

### **Damon Cup:**

(Stroke Play) In 1929, Mr. & Mrs. Damon, who were original members of the Springhaven Club, donated this Cup for the women golfers. It was played in the spring to start the season with a worthwhile tournament. Ties will be broken with an 18-hole playoff. If there is no winner after 18 holes, there will be a sudden death playoff.

### **Club Championship/Senior Club Championship:**

(Stroke Play) All women golfing members of the Springhaven Club are eligible to compete for the title of Club Champion. The Club Champion is the player with the lowest gross score for three rounds of 18-holes of play. For the Club Champion to be eligible for a prize, she must have contributed to the prize fund. Members of the Springhaven Women's Golf Association may compete in their handicap class for the A-B-C-D Championship Flights. The winner of each flight will be the golfer with the lowest gross score for three rounds of 18-hole play. To be eligible for Senior Club Championship, you must be at least 65 years of age. If you qualify as a senior and win the Club Championship, you win both titles: Club and Senior Club Championship. Ties to be played before the end of June. Ties will be broken with an 18-hole playoff. If there is no winner after 18 holes, there will be a sudden death playoff. Pairings for the second and third rounds must be according to score, not by class.

### **Wetherill Cup:**

(Match Play) In 1933, Mrs. Florence Wetherill donated the cup in memory of her father, Richard Wetherill, an original member of Springhaven. The qualifying round (to select 16 players) is a low net full handicap match. The next four rounds are match play with the loser of each match being eliminated. Golfers that are not available for each match should not play the qualifying round. The same handicap is used throughout. Ties will be broken by a three-hole playoff.

### **Groome Cup:**

(Stroke Play): In 1929, Mrs. Dangerfield Groome, one of the original members of the Springhaven Club, donated this silver platter. At the time, it was requested that the tournament be played in early October to finish off the golfing season. Ties will be broken with an 18-hole playoff. If there is no winner after 18 holes, there will be a sudden death playoff.

### **Muriel Stuber Memorial Trophy:**

(Stroke Play) In 1983, this trophy was given to the Tuesday golfers in memory of Muriel Stuber. Muriel was the winner of fifteen cup tournaments at the Springhaven Club. She won the Damon Cup in 1943 and the Groome Cup in 1971. In between, she was Club Champion four times and winner of the Wetherill Cup on six occasions. Ties will be broken with an 18-hole playoff. If there is no winner after 18 holes, there will be a sudden death playoff.

## EXPLANATION OF TROPHY EVENTS (cont'd)

### **Ida Dixon Tournament Women's Golf Association of Philadelphia:**

Ida Dixon was a golfing member at the Springhaven Club. She was president of the Women's Golf Association of Philadelphia from 1911 to 1916. The first Ida Dixon was played at Springhaven in 1917 and the following year at Wilmington. The Ida Dixon has been played at Springhaven every year since 1919. In 1956, the Ida Dixon Tournament officially became an event of the Women's Golf Association of Philadelphia.

### **Eleanor Reed Member-Member Tournament:**

This is a tournament that was started in 2004 to celebrate our 100th Anniversary Year. It is now an annual event. It includes Tuesday and Wednesday lady golfers. There are 9- and 18-hole divisions. To qualify as a tournament there must be at least 6 participants in each division. Prizes for low net will be awarded. Winners' names will be engraved on the Eleanor Reed trophy.

### **Ida Dixon Season Long Better Ball of Partners:**

Partners are flighted according to handicap in flights of 6. Each team plays the other teams within their flight accumulating points for each hole. If only one player of a team can attend a match, the handicap of the lowest handicap of the foursome will be used, even if that player is not playing. Flight ties will be broken by one 18-hole playoff. If at the end of the 18-hole playoff the teams are still tied, the winner will be determined by a 3-hole playoff. The winners of each flight play off in an alternate shot format for the overall winner. No refunds after April 30th.

## CLUB TOURNAMENTS

### **Sadie Hawkins:**

This is a mixed tournament where the ladies invite a gentleman to play golf. The format is 18-hole stroke play with modified alternate shot.

### **Janice Valente 6-Club Tournament:**

Each team consists of 6 players who pick an order of rotation before teeing off. That order continues throughout the 18-hole round. Club options are limited to 5 irons and 1 wood. The player must play all of their shots with their selected club. This tournament was started by our 15 time Club Champion, Janice Valente in 1995 and is traditionally one of the best attended golf events of the season. Guests are welcome.

### **Men's Tournaments that include one or more women's flights:**

First place winners will each receive 5 points and runners up will each receive 3 points. A playoff will not be held unless there are four or more women's flights in the tournament.

## GUIDELINES TUESDAY/WEDNESDAY GOLFERS

**To be eligible for joining Tuesday golf, golfer's maximum handicap must be 36 or less. Wednesday golfers' handicaps can be 36 or higher.**

**Date of Play:** Tournaments will be played on Tuesday/Wednesday unless otherwise noted in the Schedule of Events.

**Sign-Up:** Sign-up sheets are available for the next week's tournament prior to 8:00am on the week preceding the event. The deadline for sign-up is Thursday by close of Pro Shop. A player may write-in a time range for a desired tee time. The sign-up sheet contains a column for "Specific Tee Time Request Due to Work or Emergency." It is your responsibility to call your scheduled partner and the Pro Shop if you cannot play.

When playing in foursomes, the Pro's computer will randomly draw foursomes to include a player from each class. The Pro will draw a blind partner in the appropriate handicap class for groups that have less than four participants.

**Starting Time:** 8:00 A.M. is the starting time with tee time intervals for twosomes at 8 minutes, and foursomes at 10 minutes. The Pro's computer will randomly assign tee times. An attempt is made to honor "Specific Tee Time Requests Due to Work or Emergency." Tee times are posted by the Pro, by 12:00 NOON on the Friday preceding the tournament, for participants to check their starting time. If your partner does not show at your scheduled time, you may play as a threesome either with the twosome in front of or behind your scheduled tee time. Please invite faster twosomes to play through.

# GUIDELINES TUESDAY/WEDNESDAY GOLFERS

(cont'd)

## Conditions of Competition

1. All tournaments will be played in accordance with The USGA Rules of golf.
2. Tournaments will be played to a maximum handicap of 44 except for Tuesday Golfers, see Page 25, Sec.1A.
3. In stroke play events, the ball must be holed out. NO GIMMIES! (Rule 3-2)
4. The Pro is responsible for posting scores on the tournament sheet by class immediately after the round of golf.
5. A dated score card must be turned in at the completion of the round. The score card must be signed by the scorer and counter-signed by the player to be eligible for prizes/points. (Rule 6-6b)
6. Ringer Book – Players should post their best score for each hole, throughout the season, in the Ringer Binder in the Pro Shop. Ringers must have been scored on 18-hole rounds only on Tuesday or Thursday events.
7. Putts and Birdies/Pars should be completed only on days of scheduled events and only on 18-hole rounds. Complete putts, birdies, pars in the Binder in the Pro Shop. Class C players may substitute pars for birdies.
8. Every player shall play without undue delay. Between completion of a hole and playing from the next tee, the players shall not unduly delay play. (Rule 6-7)
9. If a match fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than one clear hole on the players in front, it should invite the match following to pass. (Priority on the Course Page 14).
10. No one is eligible to compete in tournaments for prizes or points unless the player has contributed to the prize fund prior to playing.

Prize Fund: To participate in the prize fund, you must have a ladies Springhaven golf membership.

## GENERAL TOURNAMENT RULES

1. MAXIMUM HANDICAPS: 36 for 9-holers; 22 for 18-holers playing a 9-hole round; 44 for 18-holers playing an 18-hole tournament. Exception: Tuesday golfers see Page 25, Section 1A.
2. To be Official: a minimum of 6 players must have teed off in the competition.
3. In case of TIE: For Cup Tournaments, see By-Laws on Page 30, Section C2. For all other tournaments: Stroke Play: Cards will be matched hole by hole, starting with the first handicap hole. Match Play: Sudden Death is played at the first hole and continuing until a player wins a hole. Exception: The Wetherill Cup – 3-hole play-off.
4. In case of RAIN: No tournament will be called for rain until after 10:15am. Players should assemble at the Clubhouse. If rain-out is called, play will be postponed for one week.
5. Should any question arise over a score for a hole, it must be resolved before teeing off the next hole. Questioning a score is a matter of clarification, not accusation.
6. In Better Ball or Partner Play, each pair of players should score for the opposite pair.
7. After the close of registration for a tournament, players may have their names added to an alternate sheet. Lists of alternates may be kept for any special event in case a registered player must drop out.
8. Those registering for a tournament are expected to participate fully, i.e. remain for luncheon and awards ceremonies.

## HANDICAPS

Handicaps are computed from the 10 lowest scores of the player's last 20 rounds. The Pro posts a new handicap sheet every two weeks in season.

- The Pro is responsible for computer entering scores for scheduled events.
- The player is responsible for computer entering scores for any Women's Golf Association of Philadelphia events. Team matches are entered with a "T".
- For all unscheduled events, the player is responsible for computer entering all 18 or 9-hole scores.
  - If 13 or more, but less than 18-holes have been played, enter an 18-hole score. For each unplayed hole, enter par plus your handicap for the hole. If 7 or more, but less than 13 holes have been played, enter a 9-hole score. For unplayed holes, use the same procedure as above.

## WEEKLY AWARDS/EVENTS

Weekly Events are based mainly on handicap play and some special skills play. Awards are given each week to a 9 and 18-hole player in recognition of her achievement. Awards are points, with a specific dollar value, redeemed in the Pro Shop. In order to be eligible, you must turn in a signed score card. Decisions, regarding problems that arise, will be made by the Chairman of Golf according to tournaments rules and by-laws. All winners will be announced at the Awards Luncheon. A player may win more than once.

## LADIES OPEN TOURNAMENT SERIES (LOTS)

Ladies Open Tournament Series, also known as LOTS on the calendar, refers to all lady golfers, Tuesday and Wednesday, who can participate on most Saturdays in a tournament in which they can earn points toward the end of the year.

## **DRESS CODE**

It is requested that all ladies dress tastefully in attire appropriate for the course. Bermuda length shorts no more than 3" above the knee, tank tops, short shorts, tennis length skirts, tight fitting apparel and the (No Bra Look) are considered inappropriate.

## **CARE OF THE COURSE**

Rake Traps, Replace Divots and Repair Ball Marks.

## **PRIORITY ON THE COURSE**

Per USGA.

Two-ball matches have precedence over and are entitled to pass any three- or four-ball match.

If a match fails to keep its place on the course and loses more than one clear hole on the players in front, it should invite the match following to pass.

## COURTESY NOTES

1. Please do not play before Team Matches.
2. Replace all Divots on Fairways.
3. Repair all Ball Marks on Greens.
4. Rake all Sand Traps after being in them.
5. ALWAYS INVITE FASTER PLAYERS THROUGH.
6. You MUST invite players through if there is one full hole open in front of you.
7. Players who do not have caddies should allow players with caddies to play through.
8. When you have PUTTED OUT, STEP OFF the GREEN and mark your score on your card. NEVER REMAIN on the GREEN to check scores or discuss a hole.
9. When looking for a LOST BALL, wave following players through.
10. Please do not enter a tournament if you cannot play ALL the days that are required.
11. NO MULLIGANS are allowed in any round for which you intend to post your score.
12. COUNT ALL STROKES including WHIFFS.
13. SINK EVERY PUTT - No Gimmies.
14. If you have 10 strokes and are not on the Green, pick up.
15. Please NO CELL PHONES on the course.

# CONSTITUTION

## **Article I - Purpose:**

To coordinate golf activities and promote interest within The Springhaven Club.

## **Article II - Membership:**

1. All women golfing members of The Springhaven Club in good standing shall be eligible.
2. New members must establish a Springhaven handicap or use a Philadelphia Golf Association Handicap to compete.
3. A prize fund is to be established by payment of dues at the beginning of each golfing season to be eligible for prizes.

## **Section I - Tuesday Golfers**

- A. Tournament will be played to a maximum handicap of 36.
- B. To be eligible to compete for prizes a member must have paid into the prize fund.
- C. Caddies or electric carts must be used for scheduled events.

## **Section II - Wednesday Golfers**

- A. Intermediates:
  1. 18-hole golfers play to a maximum handicap of 44.
- B. 9-Hole Golfers:
  1. Beginners with established 36 handicap for 9-holes.

## **Section III - Jr. Golfers**

- A. USGA Rules govern golfing.

## CONSTITUTION (cont'd)

### **Article III - Meeting**

There shall be two general meetings per year – one in the fall and one in the spring – prior to the opening golf date. The exact dates to be determined by the Chairman. Spring meeting shall include all women golfers.

### **Article IV - Amendments**

The Constitution of By-Laws may be amended at any semi-annual meeting of the Springhaven Women's Golf Association by a two-thirds vote of the members present and voting, providing such amendments shall have been posted upon the golf bulletin board one month prior to the meeting.

### **Article V - Quorum**

One-fourth the members of the golfing membership shall constitute a quorum.

### **Article VI - Rules**

The rules contained in (Roberts Rules of Order Revised) shall govern the Club when not consistent with the Constitution and By-Laws.

## BY-LAWS

### 1. OFFICERS - ELECTION AND DUTIES

- A. The Officers to be elected shall be:
  - 1. Chairman
  - 2. Co-Chairman
  - 3. Secretary
  - 4. Treasurer
  
- B. Chairman
  - 1. She shall chair all meetings.
  - 2. She shall appoint Chairmen of all standing and special committees and instruct them of their duties.
  - 3. She shall serve as an ex-officio member of all committees.
  
- C. Co-Chairman
  - 1. She shall preside in the absence of Chairman.
  - 2. She shall serve on executive board and executive committees.
  - 3. She shall be a member of the nominating committee.
  - 4. She shall assist the Chairman wherever necessary.
  
- D. Secretary
  - 1. The Secretary shall keep a correct record of all the general meetings and the meetings of the executive board.
  - 2. She shall conduct all necessary correspondence.
  - 3. The Secretary shall read the minutes of all prior meetings at one stated meeting per year.
  
- E. Treasurer
  - 1. The Treasurer shall collect all dues.
  - 2. She shall keep a complete list of all members in good standing.
  - 3. She shall pay all bills.
  - 4. The Treasurer's report must be read and approved at one stated meeting per year.

## **BY-LAWS** (cont'd)

- F. Executive Board
  - 1. The Executive Board shall consist of the immediate past Chairman, elected officers, appointed assistants and the chairman of special and standing committees appointed by the Chairman of Golf. The Board shall meet at the call of the Chairman.

### **2. STANDING COMMITTEES AND THEIR DUTIES**

- A. Tournament Chairman
  - 1. She shall prepare the schedule of events for the golf season along with the Executive Board.
- B. Team Chairman
  - 1. She shall be responsible for team line-up and coordinate all team activities.
  - 2. She shall attend meetings of Women's Golf Association of Philadelphia.
- C. Handicap Chairman
  - 1. The Handicap Chairman shall be responsible for handicapping of all women golfers.
  - 2. She shall appoint her own committee.
- D. Jr. Chairman
  - 1. She shall be responsible for all junior events including inter-club matches.
- E. Rules Committee Chairman
  - 1. Rules Chairman appoints a committee of two (one to be from the Wednesday Golfers) to serve with her.
  - 2. Any questions involving rules shall be decided by the Rules Committee.

## **BY-LAWS (cont'd)**

- F. Prize Chairman
  1. She shall be responsible for the purchase of prizes for all golf events.
  2. The Prize Chairman shall serve on the Member-Guest Committee assisting with the prize selection for that event.
  
- G. Wednesday Golf Chairman
  1. A nominating committee consisting of past Wednesday Chairman and two other members at large should select a slate of officers, i.e. Chairman and Co-Chairman.

### **3. SPECIAL COMMITTEES APPOINTED BY THE CHAIRMAN**

- A. Member-Guest Chairman
  1. She shall appoint her own committee.
  2. She shall be responsible for all reservations - luncheon menu - theme - decorations - tournament score cards - scoring and prizes for that event.
  
- B. Nominating Committee
  1. The Nominating Committee shall consist of three members, one of whom shall be the Co-Chairman.
  
- C. Sunshine Chairman
  1. She shall acknowledge the illness or death of any member or the immediate family of same.
  
- D. Any other Committee appointed by the Chairman.

## BY-LAWS (cont'd)

### APPENDIX ATTACHED TO THE BY-LAWS

To amend the appendix you must have a majority vote of the Executive Board.

1. Tournaments
  - A. Club Championship
    1. Any golfing member of the Springhaven Club shall be eligible to compete for the club championship. No prize shall be awarded unless the champion is a member of the prize fund.

## WEDNESDAY TOURNAMENTS

### **Helen MacElwee Cup:**

A tournament open to all 9-hole golfers who qualify on a given day. A prize is given from the point system and winner's name is engraved on the MacElwee Cup. The 8 lowest net scores will determine the tournament contestants. The format is match play with handicap (unless opponents have the same handicap). The event runs for a pre-determined time. The 1st round of 8 golfers play Round A within one week. The 4 winners of A play Round B within one week. The two remaining play in the final round. This is to be completed no later than August 3. Sudden death in case of a tie.

### **Wallace R. Arters Cup:**

Same as MacElwee but for 18 holers. Winner's name will be engraved on the Arters Cup.

### **Emma Reynolds Tournament:**

A one-day tournament where a prize is given from the point system for both 9 and 18-holers. Winner's names will be engraved on the respective trophies. This is a low gross play – no handicaps. In case of a tie, cards are matched hole-by-hole beginning with the 1st hole.

### **Club Championship:**

This is a 9 Hole and 18 Hole Tournament. Nine and 18 holers will play a two day GROSS ringer. Players will choose the best score from the two days on each hole. The players with the low gross after the two days will be declared the 9 and 18 hole Club Champions.

### **Inter-Club Tournament:**

Currently a one-day competition with Llanerch C.C. Entertaining club reverses each year.

### **Mini Tournaments:**

Once a month during the season, the Pro Staff will schedule a special tournament on a designated Wednesday. Points are awarded to 9 and 18 hole winners.

## WEDNESDAY TOURNAMENTS (cont'd)

### **Eleanor Reed Member-Member Tournament:**

This is a tournament that was started in 2004 to celebrate our 100th Anniversary Year. It is now an annual event. It includes Tuesday and Wednesday lady golfers. There are 9- and 18-hole divisions. To qualify as a tournament there must be at least 6 participants in each division. Prizes for low net will be awarded. Winners' names will be engraved on the Eleanor Reed trophy.

### **LOTS:**

A Ladies Open Tournament Series will be run by the professional staff on Saturdays. It is designed for Tuesday and Wednesday golfers who cannot play on weekdays.

### **Ringers:**

Build your best games of the season by recording your gross score for each hole on the ringer sheet posted in the locker room. It must be attested. Post ringers any day of play at Springhaven. This contest is part of the point system tally at the end of the season.

### **Putts - No Putts – Pars:**

Each player is responsible for recording the number of putts or no-putts in the notebook in the locker room. Record putts or no-putts for Wednesday play only at Springhaven. Record the number of the hole that you parred on par tree in the locker room. They may be recorded any day of play at Springhaven. This contest is part of the point system tally at the end of the season.

### **Weekly Clinics:**

There is a weekly clinic for Wednesday golfers, on Thursdays from 9 to 10am during the golf season. The staff covers golf fundamentals, rules, and course management. There is a \$10.00 cash fee.

### **Closing Day:**

On closing day in October, we have a 9-hole fun tournament, our awards luncheon, and the election of officers for the following year.

## **2011 HOLE-IN-ONE PRIZE FUND**

**New for the 2011 Golf Season is the Hole-In-One (HIO)  
Prize Fund for all Golfing Members and their spouses.**

Details of the program are as follows:

- The HIO Prize Fund is at the Member's option.
- The fee for the HIO Prize Fund is \$5 every time a hole-in-one is registered by a participant of the program. The \$5 fee initially will be billed to the member's account when they sign up. For each subsequent HIO, another \$5 will be billed to the Member's account.
- Only a HIO at Springhaven will be paid out.
- Time frame for a hole-in-one to be considered for pay out will be April 1st through October 31st.
- 100% of the payout will be credited to the Member's House account.
- Once a Member has opted in for the prize fund, they are committed for the entire season.
- The HIO must be witnessed by at least one other person.
- A form will need to be filled out by the player who had the HIO and the witness(es) of the hole-in-one verifying all pertinent information.
- Players may not claim a HIO on a mulligan. It must be the original shot.
- Only a HIO hit from a regulation tee to a regulation green will be considered.
- Membership to the HIO Prize Fund is exclusive to one person only. Spouses must be a member of the HIO Prize Fund separately.
- Any funds left at the end of the golf year roll over to the next season.
- Sign-up is at the Pro Shop.
